- Shorts, Skirts, or Dresses shorter than 3in. above the knee
- Tight-Fitted or Revealing Clothing
- Any clothing with messaging that could distract

FAMILY FIT



Family Fit is casual but still intentional. We are dressed in comfortable, informal clothing. Our hairstyles and facial hair are appropriate for professional environments, well-groomed, both clean and neat. Our clothing is clean, wrinkle-free, and fitted appropriately.

Dress Shirts, Nice Crewnecks, Blouses, Sweaters, Dress Pants, Slacks, Nice Jeans (no holes), Modest Dresses (no shoulders showing and no shorter than knee length), Denim Jackets (no holes), Blazers, Heels, Wedges, Heeled Boots, Flats

BUSINESS BASICS

Our hairstyles and facial hair are appropriate for professional environments—well-groomed, both clean and neat. Our clothing is pressed, ironed, and fitted appropriately.
